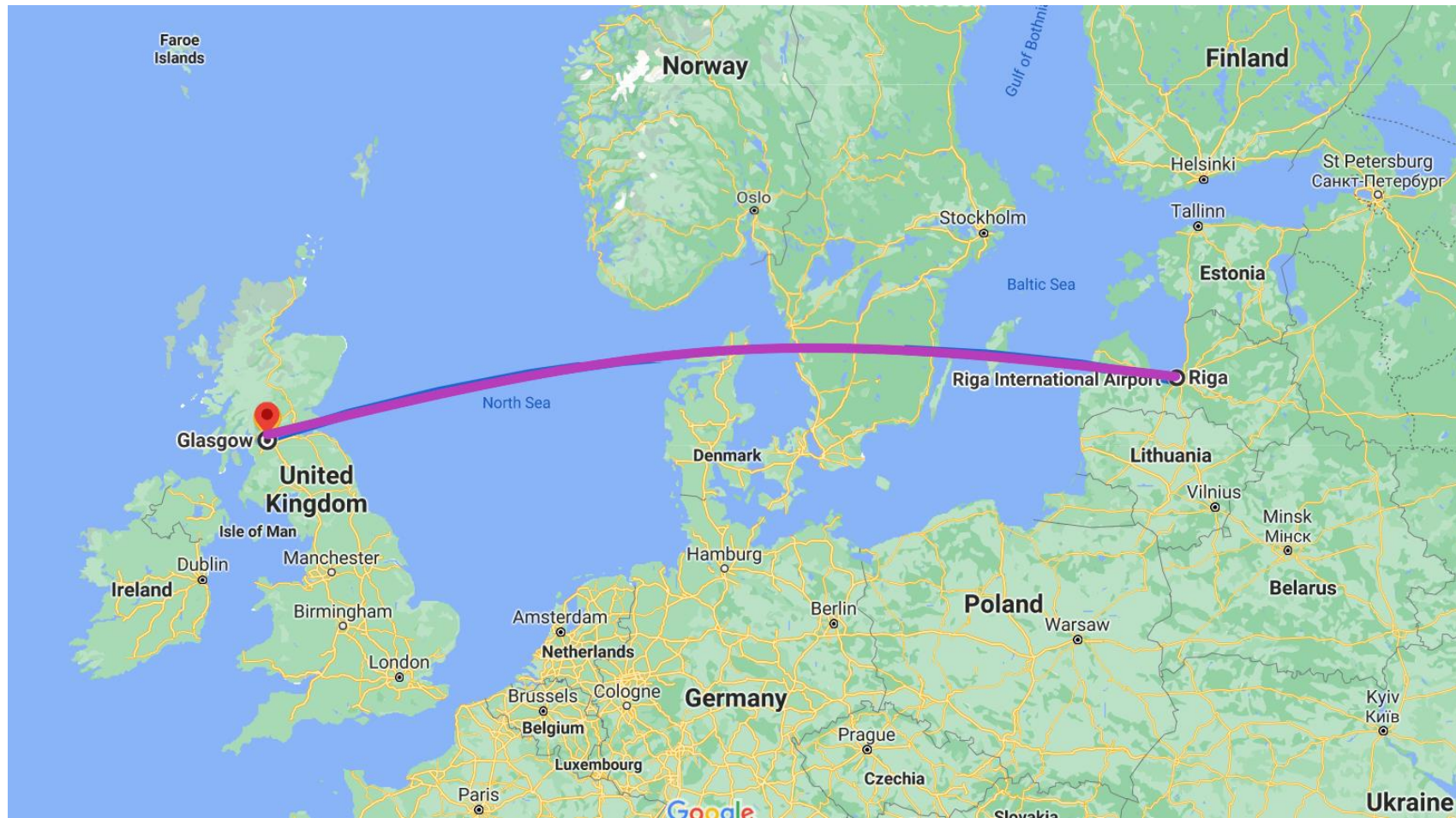

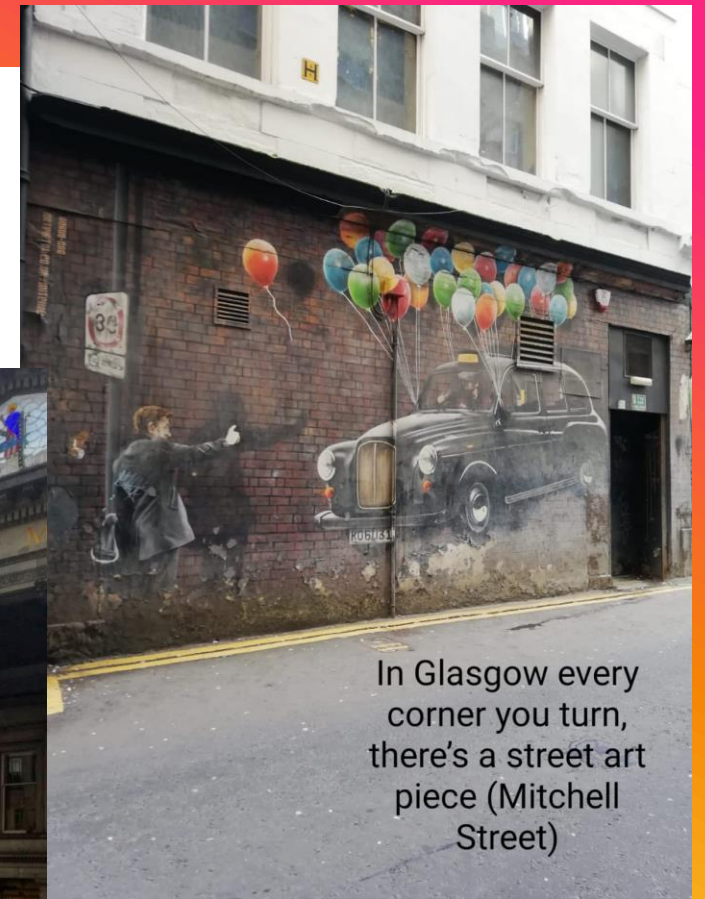

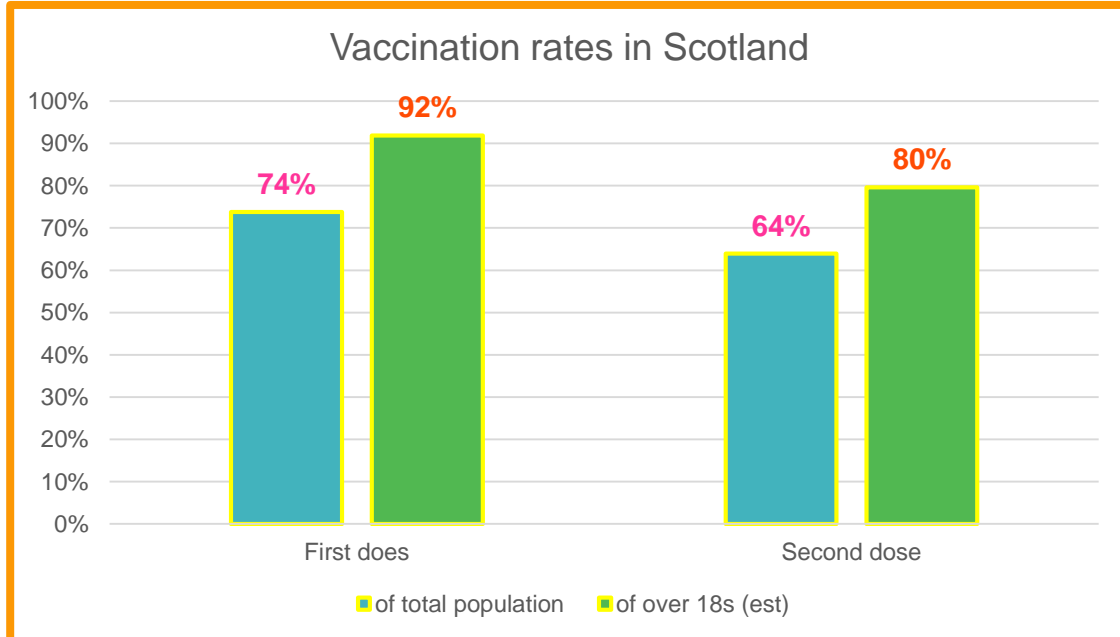

What's the Covid situation in Scotland?



Covid restrictions, daily life, since 9 August

- + **Everything open**
- + **No more social distancing**
- + **Masks required on public transport and in shops**
- + **Masks required for front of house staff in restaurants, etc**
- + Special arrangements required for indoor events with over 2000 people and outdoor ones with over 5000

Covid restrictions for international travel

“Amber countries” (all of Europe except Malta)

+ If vaccinated:

Test before flight, test on day 2 after arrival £87, no quarantine

+ If not vaccinated:

Test before flight, Tests on days 2 and 8, £170, quarantine 10 days

No restrictions on working in hospitality if not vaccinated
